

IMPORTANT – READ CAREFULLY BEFORE ACCESSING THIS DATABASE: This License Agreement is a legal agreement between you the Licensee (either an individual or an entity) and American Statistical Association and Institute of Mathematical Statistics, the Licensors, governing your use of the CIS/ED Database accessed from Licensors' website. By clicking on the "AGREE" button and/or accessing the CIS/ED Database, or copying or otherwise using the CIS/ED Database, Licensee agrees to be bound by the terms of this Agreement. If Licensee does not agree to the terms of this Agreement, Licensors are unwilling to license the Database to the Licensee. In such an event, Licensee may not access, use or copy the Database. This License Agreement is separate from and shall not be considered a part of any license for the CIS/ED Database that may be purchased on CD-ROM.

Licensors provide the Database and User Manual and any modifications, updates, revisions or enhancements received by you from Licensors, and license its use within the terms stated below:

Licensee is granted a nonexclusive and nontransferable license to access and use the Database under the terms stated in this Agreement for one (1) year for use authorized by the Level of License purchased according to the Current Index to Statistics Order Form. This Agreement terminates one (1) year from the date access to the Database is first accessed/enabled.^[1] Licensee must renew the terms of this Agreement with Licensors on an annual basis in order for Licensee to have continued use of the Database. All title and copyrights in and to the Database, the User Guide, and any copies of the Database, are owned by Licensors. Licensee is granted the right to print and distribute the User Guide to authorized users of the Database. Licensee, and users authorized under the scope of this license, may access the Licensor's web site, submit database queries, and save the results of those queries.^[2] Licensors reserve all other rights. ~~Licensee may not make copies, translations or modifications of or to the Database, except Licensee may copy the Database into machine-readable or printed form for backup purposes in support of Licensees' use of the Database. Licensee must reproduce the copyright notice on any copy of the Database or portion of the Database merged into another database or computer program.~~^[3] All copies of the Database and any portion of the Database merged into or used in conjunction with another database or computer program will continue to be the property of Licensors and subject to the terms and conditions of this Agreement. Licensee may not assign, sell, distribute, lease, rent, sublicense or transfer the Database or this Agreement or disclose the Database to any other person. Bibliographies based on more than 250 records from the Database may not be distributed without the prior written consent of Licensors.^[4] Licensee agrees to take reasonable and necessary steps to prevent violations of the terms of the agreement by their users, including suspension of access privileges for known violators.^[5] Licensors may terminate this Agreement and terminate your access to the Database if you ~~fail to comply with~~ materially breach the terms and conditions of this Agreement.^[6] ~~In such event, Licensee must promptly destroy all copies, modifications and merged portions of the Database in any form, including any copy in your computer memory or on a hard disk.~~^[7]

Level of Licenses: **COMMERCIAL LICENSE:** The Database is licensed for use on an unlimited number of computers at a single corporate site and by current employees of the corporate Licensee who hold valid passwords for access to the corporate computer system or network. Licensee agrees to restrict access to the Database only to authorized employee users and to prevent access by persons no longer employed by the Licensee. The Database may be accessed from, but not transferred, in whole or in part, outside the single corporate site. **GENERAL LICENSE:** The Database is licensed for use at a single contiguous location and may be installed on individual computers and/or on a network for on-site use only. Licensee agrees to restrict access to the Database only to authorized users, to prevent access by persons no longer affiliated with the Licensee, and to prevent remote access to the Database. **UNIVERSITY LICENSE:** The Database is licensed for use by faculty, staff, students, and visitors authorized to conduct research at an institution of higher education only and holding valid passwords to access the computer system or network at a single campus of the educational institution. If the institution's library allows access to the Database to "walk-in visitors," these persons may only use the Database at the library. CHANGE NOTES (The following notes explain changes between the June, 2001 license language and the April, 2002 revision. They are not part of the license terms, nor are the footnote numbers that refer to them.)

¹ We record the date on which access is enabled, following a request by a customer whose order has been processed. This is the logical starting point for the licensed year. We would not be able to track the date on which the first query is submitted from a particular customer.

² This sentence explains the essence of the rights under the Web license. It replaces some inappropriate phraseology that only applies to the CDROM edition.

³ The preceding changes remove some phraseology that was written for the CDROM edition but is not appropriate to the Web product. The revision is adapted to a Web-based server.

⁴ This sentence previously appeared near the end of the agreement and has been moved to be contiguous with other material on restrictions on use of the database.

⁵ This sentence was added to clarify the subscriber's responsibilities regarding compliance with the terms for use of the site. A worst-case scenario would be one in which a user connects to the database through the subscriber's system and sets up a proxy to make it available to other people who are not licensed to use it. It would be the subscriber's responsibility to stop this abuse of their system. The subscriber can use appropriate measures with its own users to alert them to the existence of the license terms and to stop abuses of the license. If the subscriber fails to do so when an abuse of access privileges has been brought to its attention, as a last resort CIS would have no way to stop the abuse except by abrogating the license and cutting off access to the subscriber *in toto*, but we would not expect this to happen.
